What is Epworth Village Learning Center?

- EVLC is an approved Interim Program School under Rule 18 by the Nebraska Department of Education. Credits earned by students grades K-12 earn while attending the school are transferable to their home school.

What is the Adopt-our-School Program?

- The Adopt-Our-School program is designed to provide supporters of Epworth Village the opportunity to be “friends” of the Epworth Village Learning Center, the educational component of our multi-faceted treatment program.
- Through Adopt-Our-School Epworth Village hopes to solicit “partners” who will have long-term relationships with the Epworth Village Learning Center. We hope to facilitate volunteer opportunities which include interaction with students, development of an in-kind donation program to ensure the school has resources necessary to flourish and increase public awareness of the impacts behavioral issues have upon society as a whole.

Volunteer activities:

- On-site volunteer time with students; helping them read, do homework, work on flash cards.
- Spearhead a collection drive for specific items needed by the school.
- Invite a speaker to come and visit your church, organization or business about the role the EVLC plays in our state's educational framework.
- Invite a speaker to present a special program to EVLC youth.
